

WILDERME RETREAT TERMS

WilderMe is a unique place with a special mission. All WilderMe profits from Cornwall Ayurveda & Yoga Retreats go towards supporting their social enterprise that runs wellbeing and nature retreats for children and adults with autism. They also help support the Rame Conservation Trust, that maintains the beautiful spot that surrounds you while you're here.

WilderMe is an off-grid, naturally wild eco-site which operates throughout the summer months and leaves no trace.

Lighting in the geodomes are powered by solar. In the communal dome, a USB solar charger is provided to charge your devices and gas burners are offered for preparing your lunches and heating water for drinks/washing-up.

Communal facilities include: 2 hot showers, 2 compost toilets, an outdoor sink with cold water tap (suitable for drinking). Only eco-products are to be used (environmentally friendly shampoo and shower gel is provided in the showers). You are also welcome to use the flushing toilets near the yoga studio.

BOOKING & CANCELLATION POLICY

Bookings:

- Bookings are taken on a private geodome or shared basis.
- A deposit of £250 secures the booking of the geodome.
- Where the booking is shared between friends, it is possible to have separate invoices sent to each participant, but the full rate still applies in the event that one participant cancels, unless their space is re-filled.
- The final balance is due 30 days before the retreat start date.
A reminder will be emailed to you with the payment options available.

Cancellations:

- Cancellations made up to 60 days before the retreat start date will be issued a full refund of the deposit paid.
- Cancellations made up to 30 days before the retreat start date will be issued a full refund of the deposit paid if the space is re-booked.
- Cancellations made within 30 days of the retreat start date are not entitled to a refund of the balance paid, unless the retreat space is re-booked. Any refunds are discretionary and subject to a £50 administration fee.

COVID POLICY

All government guidance will be followed during the retreat, and you will be provided with an up-to-date list of COVID safety measures in place (if required) in your Information Pack, along with any other recommendations.

In the event of Sarah contracting COVID or restrictions preventing the safe running of the retreat, a full refund will be issued and where possible, alternative retreat dates will be offered.

In the event of you (the participant), contracting COVID in the days leading up to the retreat, it will **NOT** be possible for you to attend the retreat unless you have completed any mandatory quarantine period and provided a negative test result. In this scenario, please inform Sarah as soon as possible. Different options may be available if you wish to cancel your place, depending on your booking.

Sarah can re-advertise your geodome and if re-booked, you will be issued a refund of the rate received, minus a £50 administration fee. Any refunds offered are discretionary and no liability is held for any other costs you may have incurred, such as travel or accommodation.

With this in mind, it is highly recommended that you take out suitable travel insurance which covers you for all personal circumstances that may prevent you from attending the retreat, including injury, illness and the corona virus.

RETREAT TIMETABLE & ACTIVITIES

The timetable provided on the website is a sample only, illustrating an example layout of the retreat activities. The actual timetable of each retreat weekend will remain close to this, but the sailing trip is timetabled according to the tides and may take place on the Saturday or Sunday, starting at either 12pm, 1pm or 1.30pm. Other activities are timetabled around this excursion accordingly.

A confirmed timetable is provided in your Information Pack, which is emailed out to you 30 days before the retreat. If you require a copy of the timetable before then, please email Sarah. Retreat start/end times remain the same on all retreat weekends.

However, last-minute changes to the timetable may still be required in order to accommodate other outdoor activities and yoga classes that are weather/tide dependent. In the event that an activity is cancelled due to bad weather conditions, a suitable alternative activity will be arranged for the group.

Treatment slots are available over the retreat weekend, including on arrival and departure days. Initially, one slot will be allocated per person, but where available, additional slots may be offered at a later date, on a first-come basis.
